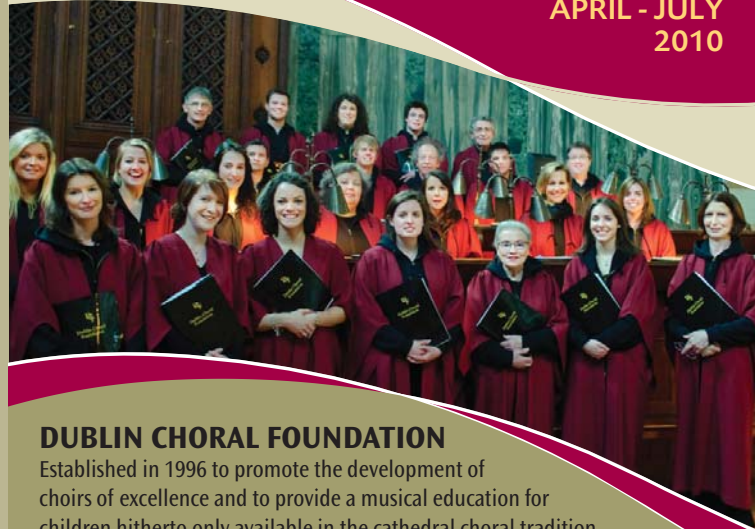

DUBLIN CHORAL FOUNDATION

Established in 1996 to promote the development of choirs of excellence and to provide a musical education for children hitherto only available in the cathedral choral tradition, **Dublin Choral Foundation** is now recognised as one of Ireland's leading choral establishments. The two choirs of **Dublin Choral Foundation**, **The Lassus Scholars** and **Piccolo Lasso**, directed by **Ite O'Donovan**, cater for singers of all ages. They are named after the great composer and virtuoso of Renaissance polyphony, Orlande de Lassus (1532-1594).

The Lassus Scholars and **Piccolo Lasso** perform regularly at St. Kevin's Harrington Street, SCR and at many Dublin venues (see **Events**). The repertoire ranges from Renaissance masterpieces to contemporary compositions. **The Lassus Scholars** sang Solemn Latin Mass and Vespers in Westminster Cathedral on Low Sunday 2008, 2009 & 2010 deputising for Westminster Cathedral Choir. **The Lassus Scholars** provided all the Sacred Music at the Year For Priests International Clergy Conference in Rome Jan 2010 ([YouTube links on website www.dublinchoralfoundation.ie](http://www.dublinchoralfoundation.ie)).

Piccolo Lasso offers a unique musical education for boys and girls aged from 9 to 15 years. In addition to performing large-scale works with The Lassus Scholars at the National Concert Hall and at other venues, the choir performs much of the specialist children's repertoire. In 2009 they travelled to Stockholm and in October 2008 & 2009 sang in Westminster Cathedral. They will travel to Rome in December 2010

Rehearsals for The Lassus Scholars and Piccolo Lasso take place on Tuesdays and Thursdays at a city centre venue. A number of Choral Scholarships are awarded to members of The Lassus Scholars.
